Biographical Note:

Russell "Russ" McKinney and Connee Wright McKinney moved to Arden, Delaware, in 1969. The McKinneys formerly rented studio space in the old Arden Craft Shop. Russ McKinney is an artist best known for his copper embossings, although he is also a painter, photographer, poet, and blues guitarist. Connee Wright McKinney worked in the Publications Office at the University of Delaware and is also the owner of McKinney Graphic Designs. Known for her calligraphy and graphic design work, Connee McKinney designed the first t-shirt for the Arden Fair. She was also a Trustee of the Village of Arden.

Scope and Content:

The Russ and Connee McKinney Collection consists primarily of graphic designs created by the McKinneys for artists, musicians, Arden Club gilds, and community events from the 1970s to the 2000s. The collection also includes work by other local artists, including Ken Mabrey, Armando Brito, and Louise Roberts.

Materials in this collection show the McKinneys' involvement with the Arden Community Recreation Association (ACRA) and the Ardens G3 (Get Going Green) Green Star Program, an environmental advocacy group. They also highlight Connee Wright McKinney's work chairing the Hurricane Katrina Relief and Rebuilding Fund and her involvement as co-chair of the Bow Wow Ball in September 2006, a community-wide fundraising event for hurricane relief. Objects related to the Bow Wow Ball are catalogued as numbers 2012.017.001-2012.017.008.
